When a child needs some help to moderate their behaviour...

We will not tolerate behaviour which disturbs learning.



Children who, despite reminders continue to disturb learning will:

- Stay behind in their own break time to discuss concerns
- Have time out with a senior leader
- Meet with the Head Teacher and parents fortnightly
- Miss out on activities with their class if their behaviour does not improve

We are very reluctant to exclude children from school but in very exceptional circumstances when we believe we have done everything, it can happen.

What you can do to help:

The most important thing is that we **work together**.

Talk to your child about how many PALs points they have received. Your child's class teacher will be happy to speak to you about totals at the end of the day.

Celebrate with your child. You will be contacted by phone, text or postcard to celebrate your child's excellent behaviour.

Celebrate with your child. When your child receives a badge you are invited into assembly on Monday. Children love to see their parents in assembly.

Celebrate with your child. Make sure they continue to wear their badges every day so that everyone knows how well they have done.

Work together. If your child has missed a number of playtimes, we will contact you and discuss ways to support your child together.
