

<div></div>		<div><div><h3>King Guthrum</h3><p>Guthrum (died 890) was a leader of a major Danish invasion of Anglo-Saxon England who waged war against the West Saxon king Alfred the Great (reigned 871–899) and later made himself king of East Anglia (reigned 880–890).</p></div></div>
