Arbor - New Parent Communication App

We are excited to announce that we have moved our Management Information System to Arbor.

Adopting Arbor will allow us to communicate with you more efficiently and bring all core school data and workflows into one system. **This will replace the IRIS ParentMail App.**

As Primary Guardian, we need you to first set up a password to access the Arbor Parent Portal and then to download the Arbor App.

We have spent a number of weeks undertaking a data cleansing process to ensure our data in our MIS is accurate from transferring over, however there may be the odd 'querble' in the system.

You can only access the App by first setting up portal access.

Having the app will mean we can communicate with you, sending messages about trips, clubs, etc. It will also mean you can keep up to date with your child's attendance. The default Arbor recommendation is that each child is normally assigned one Primary Guardian.

To finish creating your account you just need to set a password. Your username is the email address we've sent this email to.

Go to https://login.arbor.sc and click **Forgot your password?** to finish setting up your account.

After successfully completing the Parent Portal, you can then download the Arbor App to your phone from the Apple Store or Google Play.

School Uniform - Reminder

The children always look so smart and prepared for the summer temperatures in their summer uniforms this term. Please make sure that your child has a cardigan or sweatshirt for the cooler days and double check that they have their name in all their clothing. This is the time of year when most cardigans and sweatshirts are left on the playground and field and reuniting them with their owners can be extremely challenging!

As the year goes on, we always see more trainers being worn for school. Please remember that the **school uniform includes black school shoes**. Trainers are not permitted to be worn all day. If your child is not wearing school shoes or sandals, their teacher will speak to them and/or you about it.

If your child has school shoes, but is reluctant to wear them, talk to us about it – we may be able to help. Equally if there is any other reason why your child is not wearing school shoes – talk to your child's teacher or Mrs Wilson – again, we may be able to help. We have a selection of new school shoes in a variety of sizes which could be just what you need.

Finally, our PE kit is part of our school uniform – this is the time when children SHOULD wear trainers! The PE uniform polo is Dallam blue – not white. This helps us to make sure that

children are changing correctly for physical exercise and developing those good habits moving forward. Please make sure that your child has a Dallam blue PE top as part of their PE kit.
