Willow Class - Summer 2025

Our learning this term:

English - Goldilocks and Just the One Bear

Traditional Tale / Non chronological report

We will be learning to:

- Join words and clauses using and
- Use simple description
- Sequence sentences to form short narratives
- Consistently use a capital letter for places and days of the week
- Punctuate using a capital letter, full stop, question mark or exclamation mark

The children will write a new version of the story with a new character or new setting as well as a non-chronological report about bears. We will continue to look at traditional tales as part of our reading area texts.

Maths - Measure



Following on from last half term's work on length and height, the children will be measuring and comparing mass and volume. They will explore the concepts of heavier and lighter and full and empty. We will also look at money – recognising notes and coins and counting in coins and notes as well as time – knowing days of the week and months of the year alongside hours, minutes and seconds. We will be learning to tell the time to the hour and half hour.

Science - Plants

We will be learning to:

- identify different parts of flowering plants
- describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants
- explore what plants need to live and grow
- investigate the way water is transported in plants
- explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants





History - "What did the Romans leave behind?"

We will be learning about:

- the Roman army
- Roman houses
- Britain before the Romans
- Britain after the Romans



Geography - "What is a beach?" - Fieldwork Study

During the summer term we will focus on fieldwork within the school grounds and as part of a trip to a beach (more details to follow).

We will be learning to:

- sort human and physical features
- draw and label maps
- look at and compare the ground
- identify what a beach is
